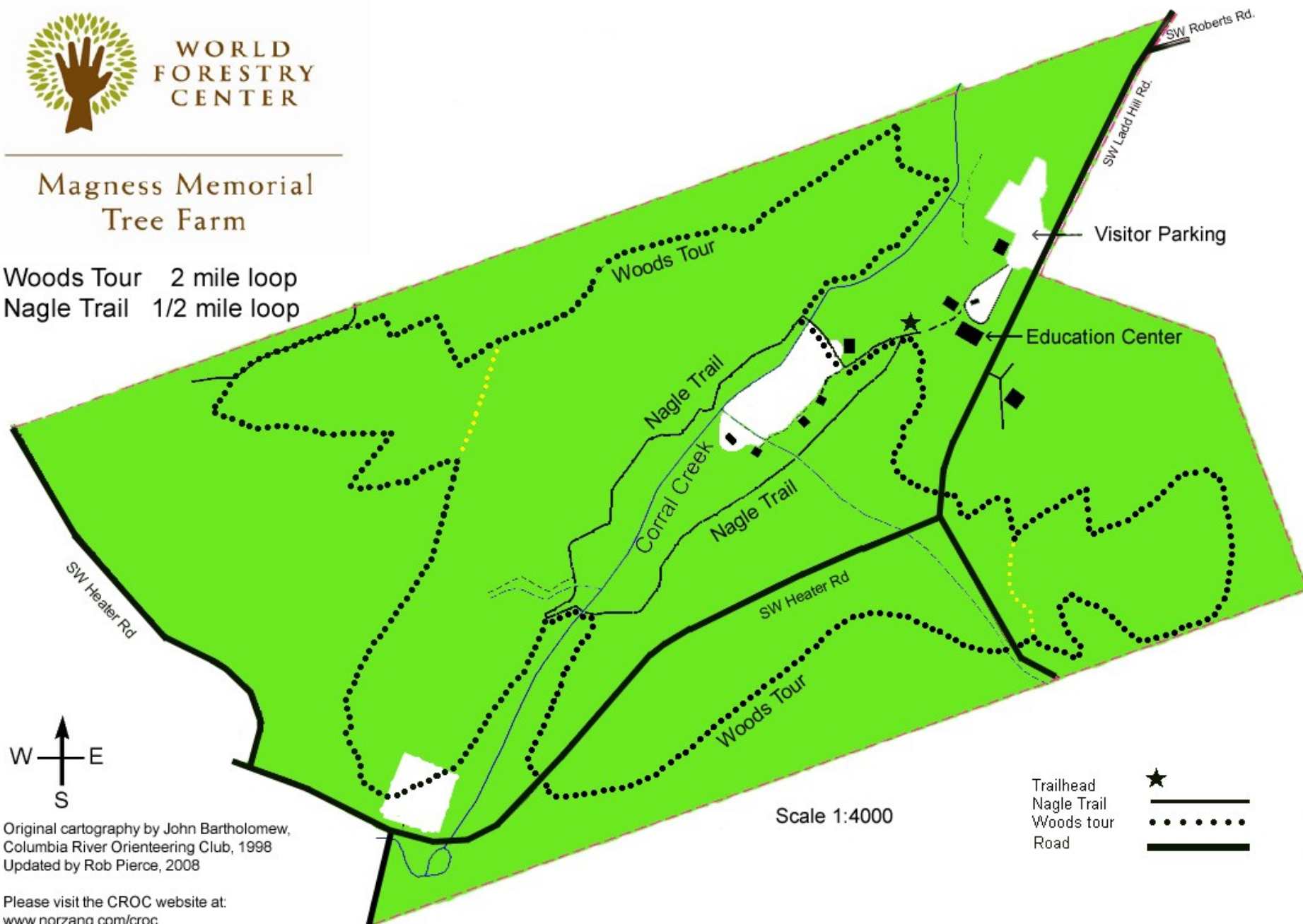
Nagle Trail and Woods Tour
